

Required Immunizations by Grade Level/Age

Polio:

4 doses at any age *

Diphtheria, Tetanus, & Pertussis (DTaP):

- At school entry for Kindergarten and 1st 6th grades:
 - o DTaP (or other combination vaccine containing pertussis, diphtheria and tetanus):
 - 5 doses with the final dose given after age 4 **
- Entry to 7th 12th grade:
 - A booster of TDaP given after age 10

Measels, Mumps, Rubella (MMR):

- Kindergarten: 2 doses given on or after 1st birthday
- 7th grade: 2 doses given on or after 1st birthday

Hepatitis B:

Kindergarten: 3 doses
7th grade: 3 doses***

Varicella:

- 2 doses given on or after first birthday
- Or health care provider-documented varicella disease immunity

Haemophilus influenzae type b

• 4 doses with the final dose given on or after first birthday

^{* 3} doses meet requirement for ages 4-6 if at least one was given on or after the 4th birthday

^{**4} doses meet requirement for ages 4-6 if at least one was on or after age 4

^{***}Two doses of the 2-dose formulation given at age 11-15 years along with provider documentation that the 2-dose formulation was used for both doses will also fulfill this requirement.
